### Home Community Acts Week Three Guide

#### **Welcome group and go into icebreakers (Icebreaker Suggestions)**

- Icebreaker option: Share about time when you did something outside of your comfort zone.

#### **Sunday Sermon Questions:**

- What would your life look like if it wasn't for the church? How would it be different? And if you don't believe it would be different, why?
- As described in the message, the early disciples made a decision to behave as a fishing boat not a cruise ship. It's not about our needs. It's about loving and serving one another. On a cruise ship, everything is FOR you. On a fishing boat, everybody has a job. Everybody has a role. What is your role in your church?
- Chris challenged us to take the next step towards irrational love here at Willamette Christian Church. What is your next step? (some examples: come next week, make church a priority, make church a family, make church your ministry).

### Daily Devotional Questions

### Week Two Devotional Questions

- Share from one of the "What stood out to you today" questions from last week
- What ways did you see believers relying on God's provision? (Day 1)
- How did you see evidence of the Fruit of the Spirit in Community? (Day 5) \*if you haven't gotten to day five, consider reading it as a group and discussing

### Week Three Devotional Questions

- In looking at Day 1 on page 35 & 36, Which of the metaphors is the most helpful to you in understanding how the church is meant to function (Day 1)
- In this weeks readings, how did you see the church caring for one another. How have you seen that in your life / in our community? (Day 1 & Day 3)

### Closing time together

- Close your time together in prayer, be sure to write down prayer requests so that you can be following up from week to week on how things are going.
