

Talk about how it is buried in darkness, but it won’t stay in darkness—new life will sprout soon!</p>	<p>Sing or listen to “He Lives” or another Resurrection Sunday song. READ TOGETHER: Luke 24:13–35 DISCUSS: What does this teach us about God?</p>
<p>WEEK 2</p> <p>God gave us the Bible to point to Jesus. What does this mean for me?</p>	<p>READ TOGETHER: 2 Timothy 3:16 How should we treat the Bible based on this verse?</p>	<p>Underline a few of your favorite Bible verses. Share why they are your favorites.</p>	<p>JOHN 3:16 How does the Bible help us believe in Jesus?</p>	<p>Make a poster of Old Testament stories. Draw a picture of the cross in the center. Think about how these stories point to Jesus.</p>	<p>Play Charades with Bible stories and characters. READ TOGETHER: Acts 1:1–11 DISCUSS: What does this teach us about God?</p>
<p>WEEK 3</p> <p>Jesus will return one day. What does this mean for me?</p>	<p>READ TOGETHER: Matthew 28:19–20. How is Jesus always with us?</p>	<p>Look up at the clouds together. Imagine what it was like when Jesus ascended.</p>	<p>JOHN 3:16 Why did God give us Jesus?</p>	<p>Make a promise to each other and keep it! Talk about how Jesus kept His promise in sending us our Helper.</p>	<p>Be a helper in your neighborhood. READ TOGETHER: Acts 2:1–41 DISCUSS: What does this teach us about God?</p>
<p>WEEK 4</p> <p>The Holy Spirit lives in believers. What does this mean for me?</p>	<p>READ TOGETHER: John 14:16–17 Who is the “Spirit of truth?”</p>	<p>Create your dream dwelling together.</p>	<p>JOHN 3:16 What do we need to do to have eternal life with Jesus?</p>	<p>Inflate balloons and talk about how the Holy Spirit “fills” your lives, just as your breath “filled” the balloons.</p>	<p>Go on a family walk together to help take care of your body (as the temple of the Holy Spirit). READ TOGETHER: Acts 4:32–37; 5:1–11 DISCUSS: What does this teach us about God?</p>
