### **About Our Church Family**

#### **In this role, you'll:**

- Ensure all campus spaces are clean, welcoming, and well-maintained to reflect Radical Hospitality.
- Handle daily cleaning tasks and regular deep-cleaning of high-traffic areas.
- Oversee room setups and teardowns for services, events, and gatherings, ensuring accuracy and timeliness.
- Support ministry teams by preparing spaces with needed equipment, furniture, and supplies.
- Monitor facilities for safety, cleanliness, and functionality; promptly address maintenance needs.
- Partner with staff and volunteers to create environments that feel inviting, cared-for, and ready for guests.
- Manage inventory of cleaning supplies, facilities materials, and setup equipment.
- Provide on-site support during events, ensuring smooth transitions, quick problem-solving, and coordinating/performing pre/post clean-up.
- Perform weekly tasks required to support all ministries and facility requirements, such as: Building and facilities checks, facilities operation inspections, internal landscaping care, and neighborhood pet station serving.
- Support and complete the facilities work requests submitted, along with developing and/or performing required preventative maintenance (PM) procedures, both managed through the facilities maintenance software.

- Partnering with Hospitality Team on weekly laundry requirements, recycling tasks, and setup/teardown assistance.
- Partner with our building tenant in support of their facilities priorities while maintaining the building space that is occupied and shared.
- Embody a servant-hearted posture, ensuring every space helps people feel seen, valued, and welcomed.

**All of our staff members are leaders who:**

- Set the standard for a consistent Christ-like character, properly aligned with Scripture.
- Promote and foster healthy relationships with staff members, volunteers and attendees.
- Maintain an active, supportive and engaged relationship with staff members at all campuses.
- Demonstrate character-based leadership with staff, volunteers and attendees.
- Communicate consistently and clearly with staff, volunteers and attendees.
