THIS WEEK WE'RE LEARNING:

CALMING THE STORM
MATTHEW 8:23-27

MEMORY VERSE:

"Everyone who heard him was amazed."

LUKE 2:47, NIV

MOTIONS:

Everyone - arms out and around
who heard him - hands behind ears)
was amazed - hold hands like
binoculars

PRAYER:

Dear God, thank You for sending Jesus to help us when we're afraid. Help [child's name] remember that Jesus is with her when she is afraid. Jesus is amazing, because He has the power to do anything! You are the best, God, and we love You very much. In Jesus' name, amen.

FAMILY ACTIVITIES:

CALM THE STORM!

what you do: Use a towel and something to represent boats (like sponges or pieces of paper). Pick up the towel and move your arms up and down, slowly at first like the storm is just starting. (Toss the boats onto the towel.) Pretend the storm is getting bigger until you say STOP! Jesus told the storm to stop, and what happened? The storm stopped because Jesus is out-of- thisworld amazina!

STORMY WEATHER

WHAT YOU DO: Fill a plastic bin or the bathtub with water and have your children place toys or paper boats in the water. Show them how to make waves with their hands and play with the boats inside. Remind them of how scary a storm like this would have been...but how amazing Jesus is for being able to calm it down.
