Hang your ant drawing somewhere you will see it this week, and start each day "considering the ant and its ways."

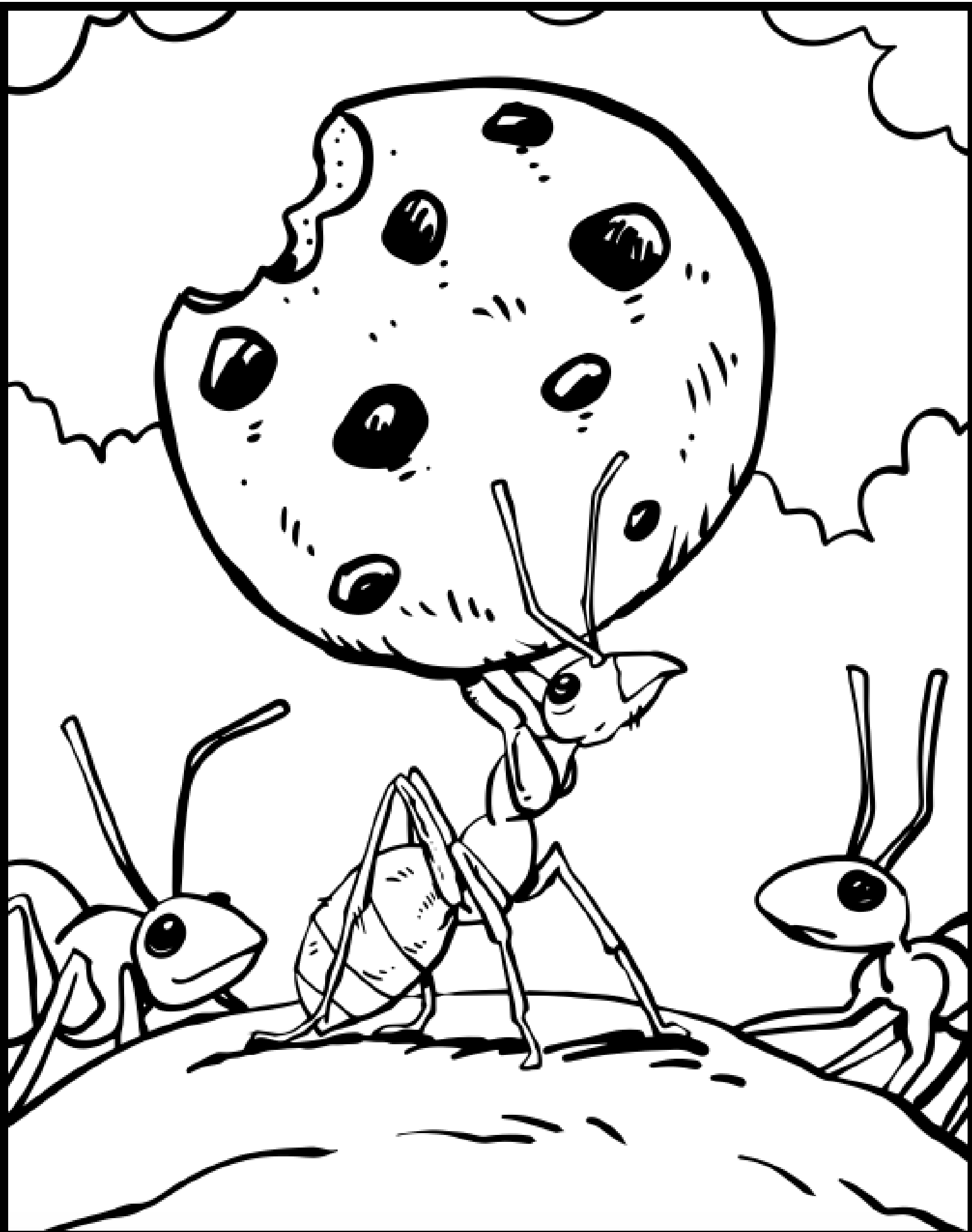
Unscramble the Words
