Stick It to 'Em

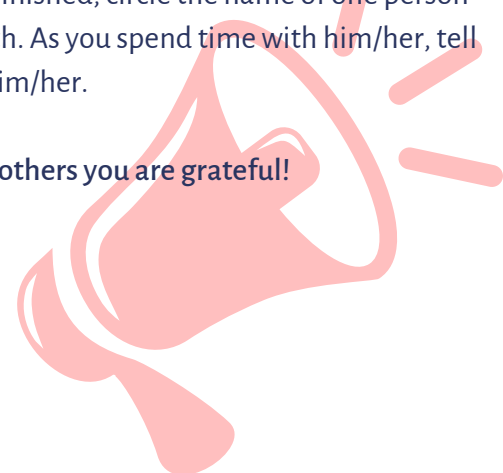

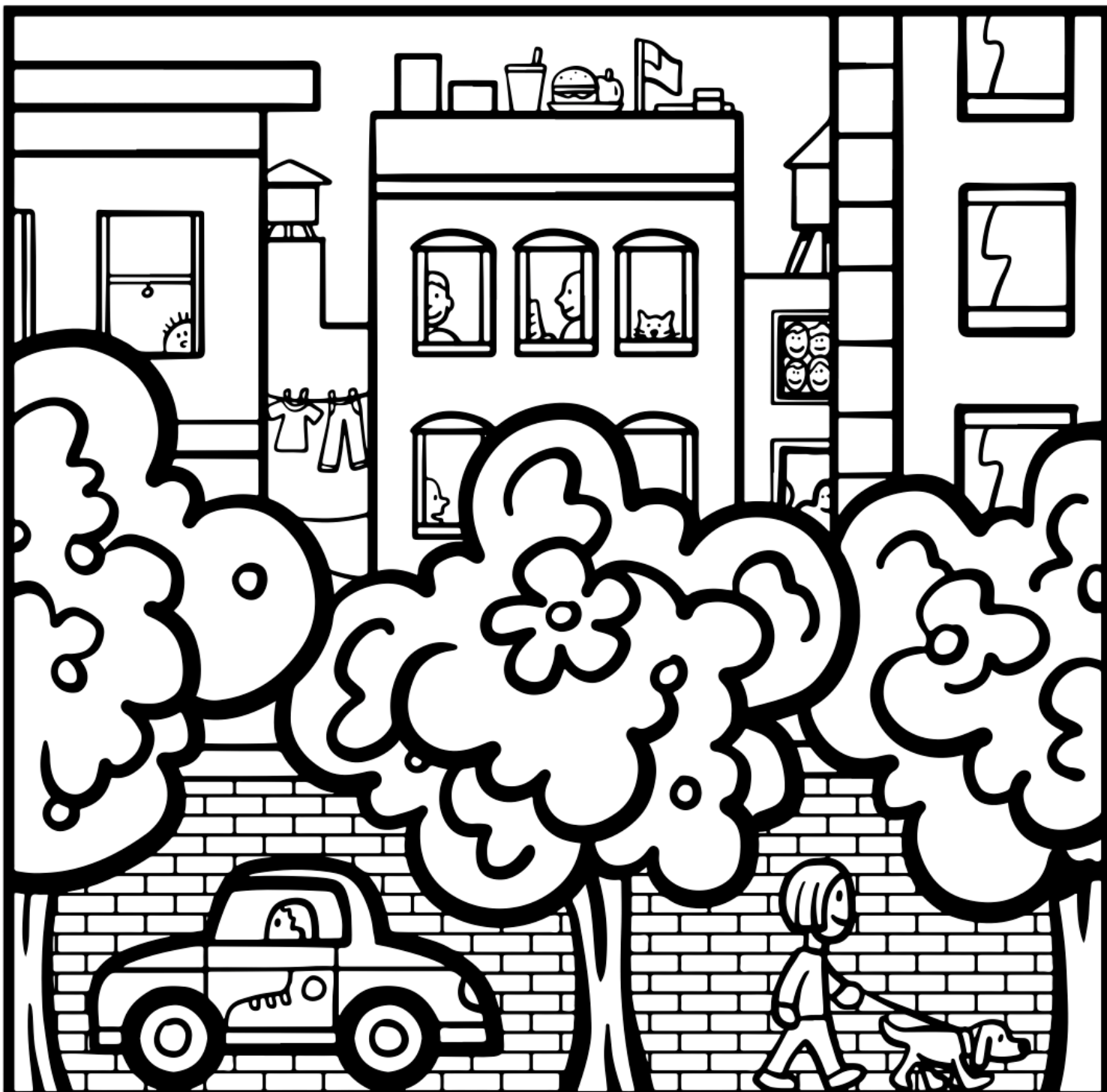
Look for ways to show others you are grateful!
