MOTIONS:

FAMILY ACTIVITIES:

LITTLE HEARTS, BIG HEART

WHAT YOU NEED: A heart drawn on a 8.5x11 paper (or larger), scissors, tape or glue, smaller construction paper hearts in lots of colors

WHAT YOU DO: Tape the heart to the wall or table. Help your child put glue on the back of the little hearts and place them inside the big heart. Continue until the big heart is filled with all the little hearts. Remind them that today's story from the Bible was about how God loves us so much. His love is even bigger than this heart we made!

GOD LOVES ME PUZZLE

WHAT YOU NEED: "Puzzle" (attached), scissors, crayons

what you do: Print the puzzle page and have your children color it. Help them cut it out and then encourage them to put the pieces together while you help! Say, "Look for the piece that has the letters G-O-D on it. Our story was about how much God loves you and ME! Now, look for the piece with the letters M-E on it. Put the ME piece by the GOD piece. Help your child finish the rest of the puzzle. Remind them that God loves you and me so much that He gave us Jesus to be our friend forever.
