PSALM 139:14, NIV


MOTIONS:

FAMILY ACTIVITIES:

IF YOU BUILD IT . . .

WHAT YOU NEED: Blocks

WHAT YOU DO: Encourage your child to think of different places they go like the park, school, the library, the grocery store, etc. Encourage them to name a place and work together to build it. Ask them, "Did you know there is something VERY important we can do in each and every one of these places? God says we can talk to him from any place! No matter where we are, we can always talk to God!"

ALL THE FEELS

WHAT YOU NEED: "Emoji Game Card" (attached)

what you do: Print or show your child the screen of the emoji game card. Have your child pick which emotion they want to act out in each round of the game. Before they start, point to each emoji and ask them if they know what it is. When they see the face on their card, they will make the same face and that you will try to guess what they're feeling. At the end, tell your kids that we can talk to God no matter how we are feeling: when we are sad, happy, angry, or even silly. We can talk to God anytime, anywhere, about anything! God wants to talk to you because He made you!
