THIS WEEK WE'RE LEARNING:

God takes care of me.

EXODUS 1:22-2:10

MEMORY VERSE:

God is with you wherever you go.

JOSHUA 1:9, NLT

MOTIONS:

God - point both hands straight up

is with you - point out to a friend

wherever - wave hands in a circle

you go - march in place

FAMILY ACTIVITIES:

BUILD A RIVER

WHAT YOU DO: Lay out a towel on the floor or table and ask your kids to help you build a river. Encourage them to find 10 blue items to make the water (place them on the towel) and 10 green items to make the reeds around the river (place on the edges of the towel). Ask your child about the river in today's story.

BABY IN A BASKET

WHAT YOU DO: Print the baby and basket images provided (or draw your own!). Place a piece of looped wall tape to the back of the baby picture and attach the basket to the wall at your child's eye level. Have your child walk up to the wall, close their eyes, and attempt to place their baby in the basket. Have them tell you what they remember about a baby in a basket in today's story.
