

Why Talbot Embedded?

Talbot Embedded is seminary education designed for students who want the full depth of a Talbot School of Theology education in a flexible, local format. Many students feel torn between pursuing rigorous theological training and staying rooted in their current ministry, church, or community. Talbot Embedded bridges that gap.

Stay rooted: Serve faithfully where God has placed you while earning a fully accredited MA.

Go deeper: Engage Talbot's rigorous biblical and theological training in a close cohort community.

Be formed: Grow in spiritual maturity, academic strength, and ministry skill within a Christ-centered community.

What Does the Program Look Like?

Talbot Embedded brings the MA and MDiv to your location. Courses blend online learning with in-person cohort intensives at a local host site. This model keeps students rooted in their church and ministry while they learn from Talbot's trusted faculty.

Hybrid courses: Online learning paired with three yearly in-person gatherings (Thursday–Saturday).

Cohort model: Learn and grow alongside a group of peers walking the same journey.

Talbot faculty: The same professors and curriculum as students on Biola's main campus.

Practical integration: Apply classroom learning directly into your local ministry and life.
